Dear Members,

Welcome to the 2017–18 skating season. Although I hope you enjoyed a leisurely summer break, it is now time to renew your Cambridge Skating Club membership.

Attached is the membership renewal form for the 2017–18 season. **Please return your completed form plus a check for your dues, postmarked no later than October 6, 2017.** (Payment by credit card is not an option at this time.) Outstanding charges from the 2016–17 season must be paid before renewal.

As in years past, members who submit renewals after the deadline (October 6) will be placed at the end of the current waitlist. Late renewals, upon payment of a late fee, are no longer an option.

Please note that membership categories (listed below) and privileges remain as they were last season, including the addition of a Couples membership and no skating privileges for Inactive members.

Membership Categories

Family Membership – \$435

Full skating privileges for two adults and all children under 25 (as of September 1, 2017) living in one household. One address listed in directory. (Single parents with one or more children under 25 are considered to be a family.) Family members may bring guests, signing them in upon arrival.

Fees for Adult Hockey will apply in addition to Family Membership dues.

Note: A Junior Member from the 2016–17 season, who turned 25 before September 1, 2017, is eligible to become an Individual Member. To do so, he/she should complete a renewal form (no application required) and send the dues check, postmarked by October 6. This option is available only in the year the individual turns 25.

Couple Membership (New) – \$365

Full skating privileges for couples, married or living together, at the same address. One address listed in directory. Only couples with no children under age 25 (as of September 1, 2017) are eligible for this membership. Couple members may bring guests, signing them in upon arrival.

Fees for Adult Hockey will apply in addition to Couple Membership dues.

Individual Membership – \$285

Full skating privileges for one adult, age 21 or older, as of September 1, 2017. Individual members may bring guests, signing them in upon arrival.

Fees for Adult Hockey will apply in addition to Individual Membership dues.

Inactive Membership – \$125

This is a placeholder membership, available to families or individuals. Inactive Members may attend the cocktail party in December and the annual meeting in March. Inactive Members do not have skating privileges or guest skating privileges. Inactive Members may switch to active status during a subsequent renewal period without going through the membership application process.

Honorary Membership – No dues

Honorary members are elected by the Board of Trustees in recognition of service to the club.

Nonrenewals

If you do not plan on renewing your membership, please contact us (by reply email, if possible) so that we don't send you unwanted reminders and can extend a membership to a waitlist applicant.

Adult Hockey Participation Fees

These fees will be similar to last year's, subject to the number of skating sessions. Sign-up forms, along with details about schedules and fees, will be sent in November.

United States Figure Skating Association

The club no longer enrolls members with United States Figure Skating Association (USFSA).

Volunteers Are Needed (Sign up in November)

As always, events at the club are organized by volunteers. If you'd like to get involved, look for an email in November regarding the season's special events – children's parties, potlucks, and more. (A preview of the season's events is included below.) The club's special activities depend on members, and we welcome your ideas for new events. We have included a member-interests section to the enrollment form this year if you would like to lend your expertise to club social activities or the care of the clubhouse, grounds, or skating pond.

Membership Proposals

If you would like to propose a friend for membership, visit www.cambridgeskatingclub.org for information and a proposal form. It goes without saying that proposers and applicants should know each other well. The club's friendly atmosphere is key to its longevity. Please note that a member can propose two (2) applicants (individual or family) per year. After the close of the renewal period, we will extend invitations to applicants based on waitlist order and the number of openings.
