Dear Members,

Welcome to the 2018–19 skating season.

Attached is the membership renewal form for the 2018–19 season. **Please return your completed form plus a check for your dues, postmarked no later than October 1, 2018.**

Members who submit renewals after the deadline of October 1 will be placed at the end of the current membership waitlist.

Additionally, please note that outstanding charges from the 2017–18 season must be paid before a renewal can be processed. Members with outstanding charges will be notified by a separate email.

## Membership Categories

### *Family Membership – \$445*

Full skating privileges for two adults and all children under 25 (as of September 1, 2018) living in one household. One address listed in directory. (Single parents with one or more children under 25 are considered to be a family.) Family members may bring guests.

*Note: A Junior Member from the 2017–18 season, who turned 25 before September 1, 2018, is eligible to become an Individual Member. To do so, he/she should complete a renewal form (no application required) and send the dues check, postmarked by October 1, 2018. This option is available only in the year the individual turns 25.*

### *Couple Membership (New) – \$375*

Full skating privileges for couples, married or living together, at the same address. One address listed in directory. Only couples with no children under age 25 living at home (as of September 1, 2018) are eligible for this membership. Couple members may bring guests.

### *Individual Membership – \$295*

Full skating privileges for one adult. Individual members may bring guests.

### *Inactive Membership – \$125*

This is a placeholder membership, available to families or individuals. Inactive Members may attend the cocktail party in December and the annual meeting in March. Inactive Members do not have skating privileges or guest skating privileges. Inactive Members may switch to active status during a subsequent renewal period without going through the membership application process.

### *Honorary Membership – No dues*

Honorary members are elected by the Board of Trustees in recognition of service to the club.

## Guest Policies and Fees

Members with guest privileges may bring any particular guest up to three times in a season. Members should sign-in their guests on arrival. Guest fees are based on the venue, day of week, and whether the guest is a child or adult. See last year's directory for a schedule of fees. Members are billed for guest fees at the end of the season.

### **Adult Hockey Participation Fees**

Members pay participation fees for Men's Hockey program and Women's Hockey program. See last year's directory for a schedule of fees. More information will be provided in November.

### **Volunteers Are Needed**

As always, volunteers are needed to help organize club events and to help care for the clubhouse, grounds, or skating pond. If you'd like to get involved, look for an email in November or use the renewal form to tell us your skills and interests.
